

## Gaps assessment

The 2011 stocktake found that the lowest level of activity was recorded by jurisdictions for priority actions designed to improve the underlying evidence base. Less than one in 10 activities contributed to high quality research and data collection as a primary focus.

A number of jurisdictions highlighted areas for further development in their overview of eye health activity in their respective jurisdictions.

For the non government sector, activity was lowest for increasing early detection, at about half the proportion of activity recorded by jurisdictions.

At the Actions level, there was no non government activity reported for a small number of priority actions. These areas coincided with areas where governments have a leadership role.
